Patch Requirements

Each Scout must turn in the equivalent of two grocery sacks or one large trash bag / box full of gently used clothing or household goods to one of the designated collection sites listed below.

Dens, packs, or crews may compile all donated items in one location for a single delivery, or call for pick up right at your unit meeting (810-762-9960 ask for Kathy)

How to Collect

You can collect items from family, friends, relatives and neighbors. Take the items to a donation center listed below. Ask the donation attendant for the sign-in sheet at the donation center and list your name, unit number, den number or patrol name, and bag count. Patches will be given to each Scout who has met the requirement.
