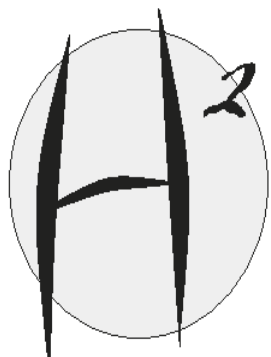

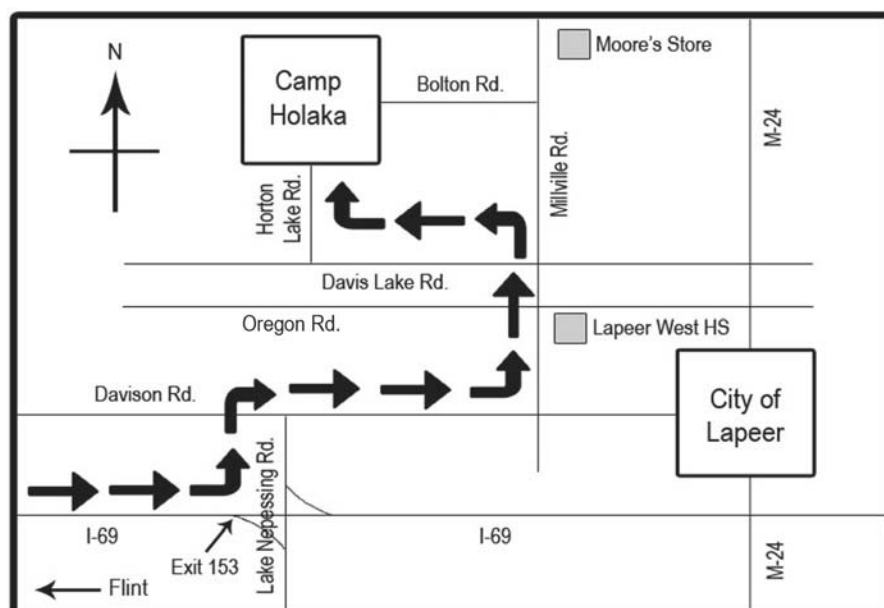
**\*REFUNDS!\***

# Cub Scout Summer Camp

If you haven't heard by now, Cub Scout Summer Camp has been one of the most amazing & fun-filled events ever to be held at Camp Holaka, Lapeer, MI. 2007 will be a summer to remember!

**During the week you can participate in archery, BB guns, swimming, crafts and camp wide events that are not to be missed.**

What is the difference between 'Summer Camp' and 'Family Camp'? Your pack attends summer camp under it's own leadership - 1 leader per four boys, with a minimum of two-deep leadership. You do not need one parent for every boy to attend Summer Camp!!! Your Pack will camp together as a group in a shared campsite with other packs. The program will also give Cub Scouts the chance to earn achievements and recognitions. This camp is for Cub Scouts entering the 2nd grade or higher.

**Summer Camp has a reputation for the BEST CUB SCOUT PROGRAM around!  
Well, you can bet your last slush ball that this year will be no exception!**

## How do I go to camp?

1. Any registered Cub Scout can attend Tall Pine Council Cub Scout Camping Programs.
2. Each pack should have a Camping Coordinator. Their job is to promote camp and coordinate registration for your pack, making sure that there are enough walkers for Day Camp, adults for resident camps, organizing transportation and answering any questions you or your parents may have about camp. Your pack camping coordinator will have all the registration forms needed to sign up for camp.
3. Find out from your parents which camps the boys want to attend. Have the parents fill out the registration form provided by your pack camping coordinator and return it to him or her with the appropriate fees. Parents should register for camp through the pack.
4. Your pack camping coordinator will then register all of the Cub Scouts in your pack for the various camps.

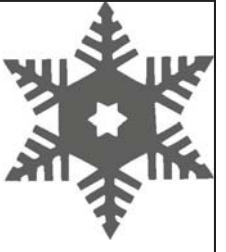
**What is Day Camp?** This is a fun adventure for you and your son, under the supervision of trained volunteer leadership and carried on in an outdoor setting. The program of the camp is designed to meet the needs and interests of boys in preparation for achievements, electives and activity badges within the program of their packs.

**Who can attend?** Any registered Tiger Cub, Cub Scout, or Webelos Scout **who will be entering 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th grade in the fall** is eligible to attend Day Camp. New Tiger Cubs entering the 1st grade MUST have an Adult Partner with them (not a Pack walker).

**What is a Day Camp WALKER?** Each pack must provide a minimum of two adults for the first eight boys attending camp and one more adult for every five (5) more there after (i.e. If your pack is bringing 17 Cub Scouts, you will need 3 adults, if you are bringing 21 Cub Scouts you would need to have 4 adults). Walkers attend day camp all day and you will need to have enough adults for each day of the week (a walker does not have to commit to attending every day). Each adult attending needs to complete a health history form. Walkers are responsible for maintaining the discipline in their den and to get them to program areas. At program areas such as crafts or shooting sports you may be asked to help. It is a lot of fun, and a great way to spend a summer day with your son or grandson.

**Tot Lots:** Some of the camps will provide a Tot Lot for younger children of adults who are serving as Walkers, or as Day Camp staff members. This information will be included in the information sent to you prior to camp by the camp director; or check with your Pack Camping Coordinator. If your camp offers a Tot Lot program you may bring siblings (potty trained and older). Cub Scouts will be the only youth allowed in program areas.

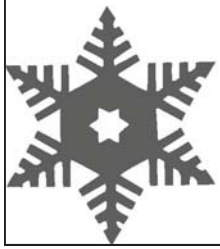
**Rainy day policy:** In the event of inclement weather there are alternate plans to continue the program. However, in case of severe weather listen to radio advisories.
